

#### COVER ARTIST: Susan Seddon-Boulet 1941-1997



Susan Seddon-Boulet's art has had a profound influence on many people. She was a prolific artist whose themes ranged from portrayals of medieval figures and fantasy characters in her early work to goddesses and shaman figures in more recent images. Working principally in oil pastel, inks and occasionally pencil, she developed a distinctive personal style characterized by the use of color applied in layers from which dream-like forms emerged. Susan Boulet drew her inspiration from a wide variety of sources: mythology and poetry, Jungian psychology and worldwide spiritual traditions, as well as a deep love of animals and the natural world. Underlying her work is a spiritual quality and a universality which strikes a chord in people from many walks of life. Her paintings have been widely reproduced and are held in collections around the world.

#### **ISHTAR**



Ishtar is the multilayered Babylonian creator goddess, the source of all life and embodiment of the power of nature. She is the giver of plenty, a lawgiver, a judge, the goddess of time as well as the goddess of both love and war. Her name means "giver of light" and derives from her role as queen of heaven. She is the planet Venus as both morning and eveningstar, and her girdle is the zodiacal belt. Ishtar descends to the underworld and restores the vegetation god, Tammuz, to life and thus restores fertility to the earth. As she descends, she removes a veil at each gate. While she is underground, all life on earth is depressed and nothing comes to life. Ishtar is a multifaceted, powerful symbol of a forthright mode of being that is unafraid to venture into the depths of the underworld. She represents the creative feminine, active and strong.

## PAUL VASTOLA - ROCKY MOUNTAIN RECORDERS







### **The Torii Gates**

On March 11, 2011, the Tohoku region of Japan was hit by a massive earthquake and tsunami. Although the disaster brought great hardship and pain to innumerable people, it also produced many stories that demonstrate the depth of the human connection. These include the story of two kasagi (wooden crossbeams on Torii Gates that mark the entrance to Shinto shrines) washed away by the tsunami, drifted across the Pacific to wash ashore on the coast of Oregon, and finally returned to Japan. The return of the Torii Gates is a compelling narrative of the powerful support given to the victims of the disaster by scores of people who were not directly affected. The story of the Torii Gates will no doubt become an inspiration to those who were affected by the disaster, and to all those who hear about it, as a sign of hope and connection with humanity.

I am honored to be teaching an incredibly multi-talented teenage piano student, Parker Geissler. Parker heard the story of the Torii Gates and felt inspired to create his own impression of the story using oil paints as a medium. The CEO of the Omomuki Foundation, Geoffrey Hoefer, saw Parker's picture and was so impressed that he brought it across the ocean to Hachinohe, Japan, where it will now hang in the town's city hall.
